## **The Julian High School School Site Council Needs You!**

The purpose of this council is to:

1. Develop and recommend the Single Plan for Student Achievement.
2. Have ongoing responsibility to review with the principal, teachers, classified personnel, pupils and the community the implementation of the school improvement program and to assess periodically the effectiveness of the program.
3. Annually review the school improvement plan and, if necessary, make modifications in the plan to reflect changing improvement needs and priorities.
4. Serve in an advisory capacity to administration and Board, and perform additional functions as outlined in district policy.
5. Take other actions as required by the Education Code.

Membership of the council is composed of the principal, school personnel, parents and pupils. All Site Council members attend once monthly meetings and serve two-year terms (August to June). Parents shall be elected in August and shall begin serving at the September meeting. The Site Council Election Committee shall conduct elections. All elections shall be concluded by August 31. In lieu of election, members may volunteer to serve.
